When creating these wines, we focus on working with micro farmers that farm naturally and work with indigenous and cosmopolitan varieties for our blends.

The wines are also expressions of the winemakers and we work with ultra-talented people that are skilled in the craft but also in tune and in touch with the ecosystems the work in and around.

Winemaker Notes:	The color is brilliant, medium-deep violet with pink hues. On the nose it is vivid and intense with aromas of black cherries, and blackberries with hints of plums, violets, and dried herbs. On the palate it has medium body, moderate acidity with smooth tannins, all in harmony. The aftertaste is moderate with a note of gentle anise seed.
